

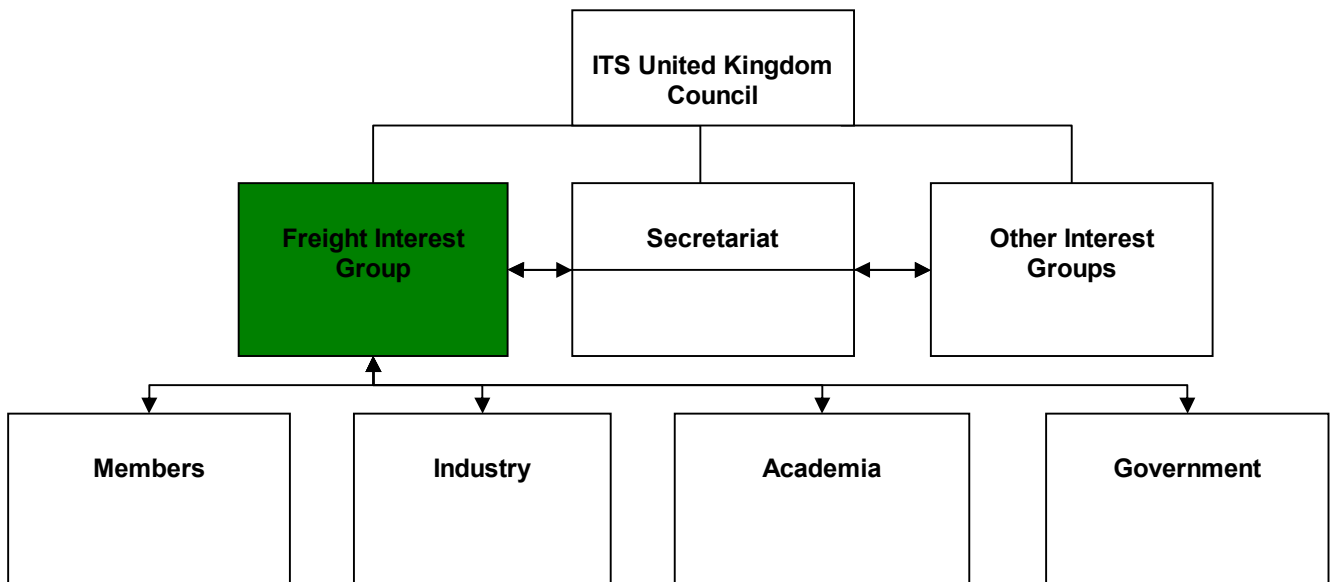
The ITS United Kingdom Interest Groups: **Freight Interest Group**
